



CDM, CFPP VS. NON-CDM, CFPP

- In 2018, skilled nursing facilities with a CDM, CFPP had an average 19% fewer Nutrition & Foodservice related tags on inspection compared to facilities without a CDM, CFPP. (Tags include 800, 801, 802, 803, 804, 805, 806, 807, 808, 809, 810, 811, 812, 813, 814, 948)
- In 2018, the average star rating of facilities with a CDM, CFPP was 9% higher than those without a CDM, CFPP.
- **From the Technomic-conducted CDM, CFPP Impact Program Study, conducted in 2018:**
 - Facilities with a CDM, CFPP show significantly less turnover. The turnover rate in facilities with a CDM, CFPP is 23% lower than in facilities without a CDM, CFPP.
 - CDM, CFPPs are more likely to use improved patient outcomes as a measure of success. The percentage of CDM, CFPPs using this indicator as a measure of success is 44% higher than non-CDM, CFPPs.



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
